## Under this agreement for 2017 Moreton Downs will receive

**\$403,700\***

### This funding will be used to

- Improve the Literacy and Numeracy results of all of students.
  - Achieve the National Minimum Standard for Literacy and Numeracy for their Year level or
  - Ensure an evidence-based plan to address specific learning difficulties is in place.
- Provide focused and targeted intervention to address student needs.
- Deliver an integrated response to Digital Technology across the school.
- Support the development of staff capability in meeting student needs.

### Our initiatives include

- Providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards.
- Providing professional development and coaching to ensure teachers are able to effectively implement the Australian curriculum in the areas of Mathematics and Literacy.
- Utilising teacher aides to provide small group intensive and targeted teaching to improve identified students results in Literacy and Numeracy.
- Providing training and ongoing support to teacher aides in the delivery and implementation of these programs.
- Providing every class with appropriate resources and infrastructure to achieve agreed goals.
- Ensuring class sizes are reduced in the early years to allow deep and intense learning experiences.
- Providing intensive support across the school to improve the Literacy and Numeracy results for all students.
- Supporting social and emotional resilience which breaks down barriers for learning.

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing additional Teachers to ensure low student/teacher ratio in lower grades.	\$152,326
• Providing additional support for coaching and curriculum delivery.	\$6,575
• Consolidating the pre-prep program for the transition to Prep for 2018 students.	\$9,000
• Providing digital Information and Communication Technology resources to facilitate contemporary curriculum delivery.	\$31,798
• Providing extra teacher aide support to identified students in the early years.	\$42,000
• Providing additional Literacy resources to support Reading across the school.	\$15,000
• Providing additional Speech Language Pathologist support for identified students.	\$31,694
• Providing additional Occupational Therapist support for identified students.	\$15,604
• Continuing prep screening for accurate diagnosis to inform differentiated learning.	\$2,672
• Providing hearing and vision tests for all prep students.	\$10,000

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- Providing additional learning opportunities for staff to build professional capability. \$12,000
- Supplementing Teacher Aide programs for the Support Teacher Literacy and Numeracy. \$45,000
- Providing additional support to deliver a safe and supportive school environment. \$9,000
- Providing additional support to develop student's social and emotional resilience. \$21,000
